Greetings LLWSC Members:

Your annual membership meeting will be held Thursday, April 24, 2025, at 6:00 p.m. at the Lake Livingston Water Supply Corporation main office located at 1930 N. Washington in Livingston, TX. We encourage you to attend this meeting in person, to learn about the significant service improvements that have been made over the last year and meet the team who will be managing operations and providing our members with water service.

Although we are still faced with some challenges, our operators continue to work hard to provide quality water and supply. I have been extremely proud of our staff for the efficient service of water distribution for over 7000 members, across six counties within 113 neighborhoods. The operators travel countless miles annually and work hard to provide water service to our members. In addition, our Customer Service Representatives strive daily to provide you with excellent service.

We continue to improve our service through upgrades in our systems. The project of interconnecting the following subdivisions: Impala Woods, Creeklake Cove, Weavers Cove, Sunset Shadows, to the Surface Water Treatment Plants; also, the upsizing and line replacement of Lake Tejas and Sandy Ridge have been completed as of November 2024. This is just one of the projects LLWSC is working on to ascertain quality water and supply. Future projects include interconnecting Lakeland Hideaway, Natasha Heights, Cherokee Forest, Green Acres to the East Surface Treatment Plant.

Mr. James Phillip Waller and Mr. John Long applied for the two director positions available and they were the only people to qualify as candidates. Because the Texas Legislature changed the law, we do not have to conduct a director election if the candidates are unopposed. The Board met on March 20, 2025; and declared the candidates to be elected. You may visit our website for additional information.

Water loss continues to be one of the major threats to assuring a reliable supply of water to every member, and as members, it's imperative that each of us alert LLWSC when leaks are suspected within our neighborhoods.
